



## **Guidelines for Poster Presentation**

- The display area for each poster on the panel board will be **100 cm length by 100 cm breadth**. One inch margin should be left around the poster.
- Fixing materials like push pins etc. will be provided.
- A poster should be self-contained and self-explanatory, allowing different viewers to proceed on their own while the author is free to supplement or discuss particular points raised in inquiry.
- The posters should be organized to include the following elements:
  - Φ **Title of the poster**
  - Φ **Authors & affiliations**
  - Φ **Introduction**
  - Φ **Materials & Methods**
  - Φ **Results**
  - Φ **Summary & Conclusions**
  - Φ **Acknowledgements & References**
- Text, figures and photographs should be readable from a distance of 3-4 feet.
- The content of the poster should be arranged in columns rather than in rows. Introduction should be placed at the top left and a conclusion / references at the bottom right. The abstract does not need to be presented.
- Letters for the title should be at least 3/4 to 1 inch high (72 pt. bold).
- Sans serif font such as Arial or Helvetica in a minimum size 50 pt. (1/2 inch high) for headings and of 24 pt. (1/4 inch high) for the text shall be used.
- Poster should be put be placed on the allotted space well before the start of the session and it should be removed only after the end of the session.
- All the posters will be evaluated by the panel of judges and the best student posters will be awarded.
